Guidance for labour market integration of migrants

The project acknowledge the importance of identifying the needs of the target group, the opinion of employers about the primary challenges in the employment of migrants, as well as their opinion on how they should be approached in the future. Qualitative and quantitative research has taken place in the beginning of the project and it produced a valuable report that is available for all partners.

The area that will be the most of importance of the Riece project is the creation of teaching programme that will help most of the refugees, asylum seekers and migrants to carry out a detailed study of how they will be able to be part in the community's employment market. RIECE will help people to plan their career.

For the first time, RIECE have carried out a study that shows that these classes really can teach at least as effectively as traditional classroom courses, and RIECE indicates that this is true regardless of how much preparation and knowledge students start out with.

The Knowledge -at the end of the course material the learner will be able to:

- Know description of work availability
- Identify the specificities of a particular country's or EU work market.
- Recognize type of work able to apply according to experience knowledge and availability.
- Discuss the role of the work availability in professional matter
- Understand the concepts on time and work experienced of the individual country according to law for labour market.
- Evaluate career opportunities by responding to the peculiarities of a particular country's labour market.

The consortium of the project is made of specialists in the field of education and training, research and career guidance, with relevant experience. The European co-operation will have a positive impact on the geographical areas by facilitation the dialogue and co-operation between providers of training programs for adults.

Local blended-learning trainings addressed to refugees, asylum seekers and migrants will be held in November. Main aim of these trainings – evaluate program.

The program includes modules for the online course and modules for the in depth face to face training. It includes in 5 modules, each one elaborated by one of the project partners: Life Long Learning, Requirements and Needs of Labour Market, Different Situations in Labour Market, Cultural surroundings, Working culture.

The objective of the course is to help refugees, asylum seekers and migrants understand how to integrate into international labour market, to plan career and establish businesses. It will also contribute to greater self-awareness, cultural awareness, entrepreneurial competences and to more efficient integration and recognition by the local communities.
